

President Rob Fenton's Message


The vocational visit to the Disaster Aid Australia office at Eumemmering last week was excellent. DAA is a project of the Rotary Clubs of Greater Dandenong and Endeavour Hills. The demonstration of the **Skyhydrant** and the explanation on how successful it has been in

providing clean drinking water to many communities in developing countries was very inspiring. A Skyhydrant can typically serve a community for over 10 years if properly maintained.

Despite the difficulty in finding the Disaster Aid Office due to a road closure of Doveton Avenue, with some phone assistance we finally all made it (other than one member who unfortunately had already headed back home). We were provided with an excellent presentation and a demonstration of the Skyhydrant. We were also served a tasty meal. We appreciated the hospitality of **DAA CEO Brian Ashworth**, and his team of **Cherie, Peter and John.**



DAA prior to the meeting, which was greatly appreciated. The all up cost for one Skyhydrant, including delivery, installation including a holding tank, etc, is \$5,000. I think all of us who attended came away thinking that this would be a very worthwhile major project to be funded by our International budget.

The Box Hill Burwood Rotary Club Board for 2022/23


As described in President Rob's Message the new Board met last Tuesday at the RSL Club to transition from one year to the next.

Last Meeting:- Vocation Visit - "DISASTER AID AUSTRALIA"

Home of the **"SKYHYDRANT"** Transportable Water Purifier

As described in President Rob's Message, Club members visited DAA office and received a briefing and demonstration of the incredible SkyHydrant water purifier. For the cost of \$5000 it can be packaged in Australia, shipped to a remote village overseas and installed to produce thousands of litres per day of purified drinking water, at virtually no running cost, by gravity feeding the SkyHydrant with dirty water from a river or stream in the area.

Cost will be \$40 per person, which will be required up front. Please pay by EFTPOS to:


